CONDITIONS

1. Any and all activity, operation, and/or noise sources must end by 10 p.m. Applicants are not permitted to begin activity, operation, and/or noise sources before 6 a.m.
2. The City of West Fargo, North Dakota (the "City") reserves the right to inspect or observe the activity or operation for compliance with these conditions.
3. Any and all claims that arise or may arise against Applicant, its agents, servants, or employees while engaged in the activity or operation, shall in no way be the obligation of the City. Furthermore, Applicant, its agents, servants, employees, or assigns shall indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the City, its officers and employees against any and all liability, loss, costs, damages, expenses, claims, actions, or judgments, including attorneys' fees which the City, its officers or employees may hereafter sustain, incur, or be required to pay, in anyway connected with the activity or operation or City actions related to the granting of this Special Permit.
4. If Applicant fails to observe the terms and conditions of this Special Permit, the Applicant and the owner and their successors and assigns shall not be permitted to obtain a Special Permit for relief from Section 15-14 of the City Ordinances for a period of sixty (60) days from the date of violation of the terms and conditions of this Special Permit.
5. The obligations herein shall bind the Applicant and the owner and their successors and assigns.
6. Each provision, section, sentence, clause, phrase, and word of this Special Permit is intended to be severable. If any provision, section, sentence, clause, phrase, and word hereof is held by a court with jurisdiction to be illegal or invalid for any reason whatsoever, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Special Permit.
7. The Applicant acknowledges receipt of this Special Permit and agrees to its terms and conditions.
